Beethoven became <u>deaf</u> near the end of his life	...you had <u>breakfast</u> at 8:30 this morning / you had dinner at 8:30 this <u>evening</u>	...the formula for water is H <sub>2</sub> O	...the Nile is the world's <u>longest</u> river
Kangaroos come from Austria.	(DOUBLE) Two plus two equals five.	(DOUBLE) I like to smoke a gin and tonic after dinner.	(DOUBLE) My sister is a policeman.
...kangaroos come from <u>Australia</u>	...two plus two equals <u>four</u> / two plus <u>three</u> equals five	...you like to <u>drink</u> a gin and tonic after dinner / you like to smoke a <u>cigarette</u> after dinner	...you sister is a <u>policewoman</u> / your <u>brother</u> is a policeman
