...Robert de Niro is a well-known <b>actor</b>	The sun <b>rises</b> in the morning / the sun sets in the <b>evening</b>
Cleopatra lived in Australia.	New Delhi is the capital of Kenya.
...Cleopatra lived in <b>Africa</b> / Cleopatra lived in <b>Egypt</b>	...New Delhi is the capital of <b>India</b> / <b>Nairobi</b> is the capital of Kenya
My gloves are too small; they hurt my feet.	I was hot so I put on my coat.
...your gloves are too small they hurt your <b>hands</b> / your <b>shoes/socks</b> are too small they hurt your feet	...you were hot so you <b>took off</b> your coat / you were <b>cold</b> so you put on your coat

...there are <b>seven</b> colors in a rainbow	...Seoul hosted the 1988 <b>summer</b> Olympics / <b>Calgary</b> hosted the 1988 winter Olympics
